- 1.) The going-to future is used for planned actions (geplante Handlungen) in the future. Example: We **are going to fly** to Greece next week.
- 2.) For things that are predictable (vorhersehbar). Example: There are dark clouds in the sky. It **is going to rain** soon.
Signal words: tomorrow, next (year, week, month), soon,...
