Practise using commands in reported speech

1 When we want to talk about someone's command, we have to use a to-clause: She told me to ask him. He told me not to be upset.

How to do it: For a positive command use to + infinitive.

For a negative command use not + to + infinitive.

When reporting a command, you do not have to change the tenses!

Do your homework! Dad told me my homework. to do do did
Listen! The teacher asked me to her. to listen listen listen listening
Wait for me! Kelly told me for her. to wait wait waited
Brush your teeth! Mum told me my teeth. to brush brushed brush
Don't go! Milly asked me onot to go to not go not go to
Leave me alone! My brother told me him alone. to leave not to leave leave
