Practise using commands in reported speech
 When we want to talk about someone's command, we have to use a to-clause: She told me to ask him. He told me not to be upset. How to do it: For a positive command use to + infinitive. For a negative command use not + to + infinitive. When reporting a command, you do not have to change the tenses!
Do your homework! Dad told me my homework. do to do did
Listen! The teacher asked me to her. Iisten to listen to listen listening
Wait for me! Kelly told me for her. waited wait to wait
