Do you know how to use reflexive pronouns?

These are the reflexive pronouns:

I - myself

1 We use reflexive pronouns to emphasise that someone did something on their own, but they are also needed when using certain verbs (for example: teach, help, introduce, hurt etc.)

you - yourself he -himself she - herself it - itself we -ourselves you - yourselves they- themselves
For example: Did you hurt yourself? I cooked the meal all by myself. The door closes itself. Hello everyone, please introduce yourselves!
She can look after herself myself myself
Can you do it by? you myself yourself
He loved the show and really enjoyed Can your little brothers dress?
Be careful your little sister doesn't cut! himself herself itself
