

## **Adjectives and Adverbs (1)**



Practise using adjectives and adverbs correctly!

• We use adjectives to describe how something is/looks. For example: The door is green and big. The question is: What is the door like? Adverbs are used to describe the verb and usually have a "ly" at the end. For example: The child walks slowly. The question is: How does the child walk?

There are also some irregular adverbs:  Good -> Well  Fast -> Fast  Hard -> Hard  Late -> Late  Early -> Early  Lively -> Lively
Far -> Far
My dog is very  small smally smallly
My dog eats its food very  quick quicker quickly
There is ice on the road, so I walk  carefull careful carefull carefully
Linda has a bike.  green greenly
He plays the piano very  goodly well good
